This is the second Baxter Family Album. Some things have changed. Rick, a fourteen year old Junior High student, now plays guitar. Duncan, the nine year old member, plays drums. But one thing is the same. The Baxters still sing. And sing they do on the fine array of Gospel selections you find here.

Betty Baxter gives her marvelous voice to "Touch The Hand of The Lord." Rick solos on a selection he wrote "How Much He Cares," while Duncan and eleven year old Mark solo the first and second verses respectively of "Lead On Lord Jesus."

Little Mark opens side two with "I Wouldn't Take Nothing For My Journey Now," and Duncan lead "He Brought Me Out." Dad Baxter, known affectionately as R.V., solos another selection written by the Baxter family, "He's The Saviour Of My Soul." Lori Ann, just five years old, joins the family on an appropriate number, "This Little Light Of Mine." R.V. And Rick close the album with the beautiful "Dear Jesus Abide With Me."

Other members of the Baxter family are Melodie Joy (three) and a brand new addition, Paula Dean.

This album was recorded in Rockford, Illinois, during June, 1966, on the *Cee Vee Records* label.
